Statement of Issue:	The College of Education wishes to terminate the following inactive areas of concentration in the Special Education undergraduate program in order to remove them from the Maryland Higher Education Commission Academic Program Inventory. These programs have no enrolled students or applicants, and have been inactive for years. The programs to be terminated are as follows: The B.S. in Special Education: Mentally Retarded Area of Concentration. The B.S. in Special Education: Learning Disabilities Area of Concentration. The proposal was submitted to the Senate by the Office of Academic Affairs following favorable recommendation by the Academic Planning Advisory Committee (APAC) on January 25 and the Senate Programs, Curricula & Courses Committee on January 29.
