Subject: Request to review scooter use on campus

This email is to update you on CTAC's work in response to the Request to Review Appropriate Motor Scooter Use on Campus –

Several steps have been taken already this fall:

- 1. Scooters not parked appropriately receive one warning (instead of the previous 3) and then are towed for which they pay a \$60 towing fee.
- 2. In order to aid in removing scooters from sidewalks (and from parking in bike rack areas) parking has been created and expanded in lots for scooters. Similar to motorcycle parking.

CTAC is also discussing the following issues:

Proposing a parking fee for scooters; proposing a license requirement; and increasing the towing fee. Again all of these ideas are still under consideration but are meant to address the transportation side of the equation.

The Senate proposal also deals with traffic enforcement concerns – which are beyond the scope of CTAC and would instead be a police matter to consider.

I wanted to share with you this update from our meeting this past week. We will continue to keep you informed as this progresses.
