

Statement of Issue:	The College of Behavioral and Social Sciences and the Department of Geography propose to change the name of the Bachelor of Science in Geography to the Bachelor of Science in Geographical Sciences. The proposed name reflects the direction of the field and better represents the teaching and research activities of the department. Two other proposals, Senate Docs 11-12-13 and 11-12-15, have been submitted to rename the department and graduate degree programs, respectively.

Recommendation:	The Senate Committee on Programs, Curricula, and Courses recommends that the Senate accept the name change.
Committee Work:	<p>The PCC Committee considered the proposal at its October 7, 2011, meeting. Chris Justice, Chair of Geography, and Kathy Beardsley, Associate Dean of Behavioral and Social Sciences, were present to discuss the proposal and answer questions.</p> <p>The Academic Planning Advisory Committee approved the proposal on September 19, 2011. The Senate PCC Committee voted and approved the proposal on October 7, 2011.</p>
Alternatives:	The Senate could decline to approve the new name for this program.
Risks:	If the Senate does not approve the new name, then the program will retain its existing name, which does not accurately reflect the activities of the program or the direction of the field.

Financial Implications:	There are no significant financial implications with this proposal.
Further Approvals Required: <i>(*Important for PCC Items)</i>	If the Senate approves this proposal, it would still require further approval by the President and the Chancellor, and the Maryland Higher Education Commission will need to be notified.
