I am writing on behalf of the Senate Educational Affairs Committee in regard to our charge on University Expectations for Limited Enrollment Programs (Senate Document #16-17-36), which has a deadline of March 30, 2018. I am writing to respectfully request an extension for the Educational Affairs Committee's review of the important issues referenced in this charge.

The Educational Affairs Committee has given the subject considerable attention since it began its work in the fall of 2017, and it has made significant progress. It has spoken with administrators in four Colleges/Schools that are involved with Limited Enrollment Programs (LEPs), as well as various administrators and offices involved in reviewing both existing LEPs and new applications for LEP status. It has also reviewed the Senate's previous consideration of LEPs. The committee has started to develop its recommendations, which it will soon begin circulating with various stakeholders. The committee believes that an extension will allow it to complete its work this year.

We respectfully request an extension until May 25, 2018.
