Review of the Interim University of Maryland Web Accessibility Policy (Senate Document #17-18-22) Information Technology Council | Chair: William Bowerman

The Senate Executive Committee (SEC) and Senate Chair Falvey request that the University Information Technology (IT) Council review the interim <u>University of Maryland Web Accessibility Policy (VI-1.00[E])</u>.

Specifically, we ask that you:

- Collect input from members of the campus community affected by the new interim policy, especially staff who support unit websites and work on issues of technology accessibility.
- Consult with the Research Council on the potential impact of the policy on websites that report results from grant-funded research projects.
- Consult with a representative of the Office of Faculty Affairs.
- 4. Review similar web accessibility policies at Big Ten and other peer institutions.
- 5. Consider whether the interim policy should be revised.
- Identify the best approach for campus-wide implementation of the policy to meet the required deadline for compliance.
- Consider how best to communicate available resources to campus units that need to evaluate and revise their websites.
- 8. Consult with the University's Office of General Counsel on any proposed recommendations.
