Review of the University of Maryland Non-Discrimination Policy and **Procedures**

(Senate Document #18-19-16)

Equity, Diversity, & Inclusion (EDI) Committee | Chair: Tom Porter

The Senate Executive Committee (SEC) and Senate Chair Walsh request that the Equity, Diversity, & Inclusion (EDI) Committee review the University of Maryland Non-Discrimination Policy and Procedures [VI-1.00(B)] and make recommendations, as necessary.

Specifically, the committee is asked to:

- 1. Review Inclusion and Respect at the University of Maryland (Senate Document #17-18-03).
- 2. Review the University of Maryland Policy on Threatening and Intimidating Conduct VI-1.00(F)].
- 3. Review similar policies and procedures at Big 10 and other peer institutions.
- 4. Consult with a representative of the Office of General Counsel to better understand the legal framework associated with the policies.
- 5. Consult with representatives of the task force and the Senate Office to understand the rationale behind the development of the Policy on Threatening and Intimidating Conduct VI-1.00(F).
- 6. Consult with a representative of the Office of Civil Rights & Sexual Misconduct (OCRSM).
- 7. Consult with a representative of the Office of Diversity & Inclusion (ODI).
- 8. Consider how to ensure that the principles in the newly established University of Maryland Policy on Threatening and Intimidating Conduct VI-1.00(F) align with those defined in the University of Maryland Non-Discrimination Policy and Procedures VI-1.00(B), and consider whether policy revisions are necessary to clarify which policy applies in specific circumstances.
- 9. Consult with a representative of the Office of General Counsel on any proposed changes to the University's policy.
- 10. If appropriate, recommend whether the policy should be revised and submit recommended revisions for Senate consideration.
