#### ISSUE

The Senate Nominations Committee has prepared a slate of nominees for the 2020-2021 Chair-Elect, the Senate Executive Committee (SEC), and the Committee on Committees, as well as the Senate-elected memberships of the University Athletic Council, the Council of University System Faculty (CUSF), and the Campus Transportation Advisory Committee (CTAC).

#### **RECOMMENDATION(S)**

The Senate Nominations Committee recommends the attached slate of nominees for election at the May 6, 2020 Transition Meeting of the University Senate.

#### COMMITTEE WORK

The Nominations Committee began recruitment efforts in January 2020. The committee sent announcements for the self-nominations period to all continuing and incoming Faculty, Staff, and Student Senators. The Nominations Committee met on five separate occasions to discuss nominees and recruitment efforts: January 31, February 21, March 12, March 27, and April 9, 2020.

Members of the Nominations Committee reached out to eligible candidates for all open seats and obtained written consent of all nominees, in accordance with the Senate Bylaws. The Nominations Committee endeavored to create balanced slates with representation from across campus.

The Nominations Committee voted in favor of approving the attached slate on April 17, 2020.
